The Countryside and Rights of Way Act 2000 will create new rights to walk on 'access land' – generally mountain, moor, heath, down and registered common land. The Countryside Agency is producing maps which show where you will be able to walk.

The draft map for **central southern England** will be issued on 3 September 2002 and is available to comment on until 3 December 2002.
