

NOTICE OF CORRECTIONS TO CONCLUSIVE MAP IN CENTRAL SOUTHERN ENGLAND

The Access to the Countryside (Correction of Provisional and Conclusive Maps) (England) Regulations 2003

In accordance with the provisions of Sections 4,5,6,7,8 and 9 of The Access to the Countryside (Correction of Provisional and Conclusive Maps) (England) Regulations 2003, corrections to the map in Central Southern England were made on 15 December 2004.

Land at Seven Barrow, located approximately 7km north of Whitchurch, approximately 0.3km east of the A34 (map reference 446650, 155150). The effect of the correction is that 2.63 hectares shown as open country will be added following an incorrect update on the Area 3 conclusive map issued on 28 September 2004, in which too much land was removed following a successful appeal.

The map to which this correction relates is henceforth to be treated as corrected to the extent described.
